Requirements and Other Information

1. This rebate is intended to replace or upgrade old toilets with new, ultra-high efficiency toilets that use 0.8 gallons per flush (GPF) or less.
2. Applications are processed in the order received and rebates are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. Funding is limited.
3. Rebate will reimburse participant up to \$100 of the purchase price of a new toilet (excluding installation costs, taxes and shipping/handling) up to a maximum of four (4) toilets. Residential and non-residential customers are eligible for this rebate.
4. All expenses are out-of-pocket to the applicant.
5. Toilet must be new and meet qualifying criteria.
6. Toilet must be purchased and installed at the water account address, in the Town of Castle Rock Water service area, during the current rebate year.
7. Rebate checks are issued within three (3) to six (6) weeks after completion of application, required supplemental information, and the old toilet has been brought to Castle Rock Water for recycling.
8. Actual water savings may vary.
9. Upon approval of this application, the Town of Castle Rock has the right and license to use my image, likeness, and comments in Castle Rock materials for internal and external audiences. These materials include, but are not limited to, advertisements, brochures, new releases, magazines, newspapers, newsletters, videos, and presentations.
10. Attach a copy of the original sales receipt to this application.
11. A signed copy of the Affidavit of Lawful Presence, along with an acceptable form of identification are required.
12. **To be eligible for this rebate, the Town requires that you bring the old toilet, BY APPOINTMENT ONLY, to Castle Rock Water, 175 Kellogg Ct., Castle Rock, CO 80109. The old toilet will be recycled by the Town of Castle Rock.**
13. Send this acknowledgement and affidavit to "Toilet Retrofit Rebate", Castle Rock Water, 175 Kellogg Ct., Castle Rock, CO 80109", or email to waterconservation@crgov.com. Submittal of the on-line application is not considered complete until the acknowledgement and affidavit are signed by the applicant and the old toilet has been brought to Castle Rock Water for recycling.
14. Failure to comply with any requirements of this program will result in denial of rebate.

AFFIDAVIT OF LAWFUL PRESENCE IN THE U.S.

(Required for Town of Castle Rock Rebate Applications)

I, _____ (print name legibly), swear or affirm under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Colorado that (check one):

- I am a United States citizen, or
- I am not a United States citizen, but I am a Permanent Resident of the United States, or
- I am not a United States citizen, but I am lawfully present in the United States pursuant to Federal law.

I understand that this sworn statement is required by law because I have applied for a public benefit. I understand that state law requires me to provide proof that I am lawfully present in the United States prior to receipt of this public benefit. I further acknowledge that making a false, fictitious or fraudulent statement or representation in this sworn affidavit is punishable under the criminal laws of Colorado as perjury in the second degree under Colorado Revised Statute 18-8-503 and it shall constitute a separate criminal offense each time a public benefit is fraudulently received.

- *a valid Colorado driver's license;*
Note: The Colorado Department of Revenue will allow us to accept a driver's license from the District of Columbia or any of the following 33 states: Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Virginia, West Virginia, or Wyoming;
- *a valid Colorado identification card;*
- *a United States military card;*
- *a United States military dependent's identification card;*
- *a United States Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card;*
- *a Native American tribal document;*
- *a birth certificate issued by a state, county or parish;*
- *a naturalization or citizenship certificate;*
- *a court-issued adoption order*
- *an unexpired foreign passport*
- *an I-94 immigration form with refugee or asylum status; or*
- *an unexpired resident alien card, permanent resident card, temporary resident card, or employment authorization card.*

In addition, you must sign an affidavit stating either: (1) you are a United States citizen; or (2) you are a legal permanent resident of the United States; or (3) you are otherwise lawfully present in the United States pursuant to federal law. A blank affidavit is attached for your convenience.

Please mail a photocopy of your identification (in one of the forms listed above) and your signed affidavit along with the other rebate paperwork.
